Zephaniah 3 From Judgement to joy



Think about and discuss one or two questions from each section.

The text – Zephaniah 3:1-20

- 1. Read Zephaniah 3:1-20. In Zephaniah 3:1-8, what are the sins of Israel? Contrast the description of the people with the wonderful description of the LORD in 3:5. Discuss 3:5, one of the most lovely texts in the Scripture.
- 2. In 3:8 we read that "the whole world will be consumed by the fire of my jealous anger". How do you understand God's jealousy? God's anger? How are these related to God's love?
- 3. God's judgement is not the end. It is for the purpose of purifying a "remnant" (3:12), that is people who truly live like God and reflect God's character. What are these people like in 3:9-13?
- 4. Zephaniah 3:14-20 contain some beautiful descriptions of God's love. Read and reflect together on 3:17. What is God like? What is God doing in this text?

The Scriptures – Zephaniah 3:1-20 as a portion of the Scriptures

- 5. Jesus experienced testing and temptation throughout his life. What was his response? Read and discuss Hebrews 5:7-9.
- 6. Read Hebrews 12:4-14. How does God continue to discipline his people? What is the purpose of discipline in this passage?

- 7. How has God disciplined you throughout your life? Can you share some specific instances?
- 8. What does God want you to do presently to grow in holiness, in faith, hope, and love?
