The text – Luke 24:13–35

1. Read Luke 24:13–24. What do the two on the road understand about Jesus? What's right and wrong about their understanding?
2. Read Luke 24:25–35. Why does Jesus rebuke the two travellers?
3. In what ways do the travellers change? How does the change happen?
4. What do you make of Jesus vanishing?
5. How would you describe Jesus in this passage?
6. Only Luke records this episode. Why do you think it's part of his Gospel?

The Scriptures – Luke 24:13–35 as a portion of the Scriptures

7. Read Luke 24:27. What might Jesus have said? What examples of suffering and glory can you think of in the Old Testament?
8. How does Isaiah 52:13–52:15 relate to this passage?
9. How does Psalm 22 relate to this passage?

Our lives – walking the way of Jesus in response to Luke 24:13–35 as a portion of the Scriptures

10. What is the relationship between the Incarnate Word (Jesus) and the Written Word (Moses and the Prophets) in this episode and in your life?
11. Have you ever had a sense that your heart was burning within you. When? Why?
12. How could you use this passage to assure yourself or someone else that Jesus has risen from the dead?
