Jesus and Zacchaeus: lost and found



The text – Luke 19:1-10

1. Read Luke 19:1-10. This story about Jesus and Zacchaeus is only found in Luke. What do we learn about Zacchaeus in this text? What do we learn about Jesus?
2. Discuss Luke 19:10. What does “Son of Man” mean as a name for Jesus? How does the Son of Man “seek” and “save” the lost?

The Scriptures – Luke 19:1-10 as a portion of the Scriptures

3. Jesus has already told some three stories about being lost and found in Luke 15:1-32. Read and discuss one of these three stories. What stands out as important about being lost and found?
4. In 1 Timothy 1:12-16 Paul writes about he turned to God and was found. What do we learn about God’s grace and mercy in that passage?

5. Tell the story of how God found you. Share your story with others.
6. Who are you asking God to graciously find at present? Pray for them now.
