John 14 - 16 Holy Spirit



The Text - John 14-16

- 1. Read John 13:31 14:8. What do you think Jesus means when he says that he is going away?
- 2. How do the disciples feel about this? How would you be feeling?
- 3. In John 14:16, Jesus promises "another advocate". This word can also mean helper, or encourager or counsellor. How is the Holy Spirit a helper/encourager/comforter?
- 4. What is the significance of Jesus using the word, "another"?
- 5. Read John 14:20-24. What do these verses tell us about the relationship between the Father, Jesus and the Holy Spirit?
- 6. What do these verses tell us about our relationship with the triune God?
- 7. Read John 15:1-11. Who is the vine, the vinedresser and the branches? How are we connected to the vine?
- 8. In John 15:5-6, Jesus speaks of "remaining" in the vine or "abiding". How might one abide in Jesus? Is abiding in Jesus dependent on our effort? How do you know?
- 9. Scan through these chapters and discuss all of the things that Jesus says the Holy Spirit will do.

The Scriptures – John 14-16 as a portion of the Scriptures

- 10. Read Joel 2:28-32. How do Jesus' words relate to the promise in Joel?
- 11. Read Leviticus 26:11-13 and Exodus 40:34-38. What do we learn about God's desires and actions in these verses? In what ways is the Holy Spirit different and similar to the tabernacle?

Our lives – walking the way of Jesus in response to John 14-16 as a portion of the Scriptures

- 12.In what sense has the western world 'disenchanted' the world through rational thinking? In what ways is this helpful? In what ways is it troubling?
- 13. What is the Holy Spirit doing in the life of God's people and our church today?
- 14. How might you respond if someone was to say to you that they feel as if God is a long way away?
- 15. How do Jesus' words comfort you? How does the Holy Spirit comfort us?
