- 2. What do you think it means that they wanted 'to make their name great?'
- 3. How does their desire to not be scattered fit with God's commands for humanity to fill the earth and subdue it in Genesis 1:28?
- 4. Why does God scatter the people and confuse their language? What is tragic about this? What is good about this?

- 1. Read Genesis 1:28. What is God's created purpose for humanity? How does this conflict with Genesis 11:1-9?
- 2. Read Revelation 7:9-17. How does this picture contrast with that of Babel? What does it say about God's purposes for humanity and creation?

- 1. What is God's mission for his world and for humanity? How might we participate in God's mission today in our town?
- 2. What are some barriers that might tempt us to abandon God's mission and seek our own agenda?
