Think about and discuss one or two questions from each section.

The text – Psalm 37:27-33

1. Discuss 37:27-29. Notice the focus on the land – the land of Israel. What are the main concerns of these verses?
2. Discuss 37:30-33. What are the main concerns of these verses?
3. “Inheritance” is an important focus in this psalm. What is Israel’s inheritance? Consider this passage and also 37:9 and 37:11.

The Scriptures – Psalm 37:27-33 as a portion of the Scriptures

4. Read Luke 4:5-8. This is an important New Testament text in terms of inheritance, as the devil promises Jesus all the kingdoms of the world. How does Jesus respond?
5. Read Matthew 5:5. What is its relationship to Psalm 37, particularly 37:11?
6. What is our inheritance? Read and discuss 1 Corinthians 3:21-23.

Our lives – walking the way of Jesus in response to Psalm 8 as a portion of the Scriptures

7. Inheritance is closely related to our understanding of “hope”. What do you hope for? Are you able to wait for your hope? Are you a patient person?
8. How can we pray for you and support you as you trust God for your inheritance?
