## The Text - Romans 9:30 - 10:13

- 1. Read Romans 9:30 9:33. Who are Israel here? Why have 'Israel' not achieved righteousness, but the Gentiles have received it?
- 2. How would you describe to someone what righteousness is? Have a look at Psalm 106:3, Ezekiel 18:5-9, Romans 3:21-23
- 3. In what ways is Jesus a 'stumbling stone' for some people in this passage?
- 4. Read Romans 10:1-4. What do you think God's righteousness is? Why haven't some accepted God's righteousness?
- 5. What does it mean that Jesus is the fulfilment of the law? How does he provide righteousness for everyone who believes?
- 6. Read Romans 10:5-8. These are quotes from Leviticus 18:5 and Deuteronomy 30:11-14. What point do you think Paul is making in these verses?
- 7. Read Romans 10:9-13. What does the way of faith look like?

## The Scriptures – Romans 9:30 – 10:13 as a portion of the Scriptures

- 1. Read Leviticus 18:5 and Deuteronomy 30:11-14. How do these passages differ in their perspective on the law?
- 2. Read Matthew 5:20. To Jesus' audience, this would have been a startling statement. How does our passage shed light on Jesus' words?
- 3. Read Philippians 3:7-11. How does Paul respond to God's merciful gift of righteousness through faith?

- 1. Can you think of some times you have found yourself caught in self-reliance?
- 2. What are some ways which we might rest in Jesus? What choices could you make to rest in Jesus?
