Deuteronomy 22:1-12 Laws for Life!



Think about and discuss one or two questions from each section.

The text – Deuteronomy 22:1-12

- 1. Read Deuteronomy 22:1-12. The Ten Commandments were given in Deuteronomy 5. Many of the laws in this chapter can be thought of in relationship with the sixth commandment: "You shall not murder". Discuss how these laws are related to the sixth commandment.
- 2. There are six groups of laws in the passage we are studying: 22:1-4 (animals and other things that are lost), 22:5 (differences between men and women), 22:6-7 (bird's nests), 22:8 (parapet around roofs); 22:9-11 (mixing things); and 22:12 (tassels on cloaks). Discuss one or two of these. What are these laws about? How do they relate to loving God and loving neighbour?

The Scriptures - Deuteronomy 22:1-12

- 3. Read and compare Exodus 23:4-5 with Deuteronomy 22:1-4. How are these laws similar?
- 4. These were wonderful laws for Israel in their time and place. But Israel failed to keep these laws. Israel's prophets looked forward to a more powerful law. Read Jeremiah 31:31-34. What are the characteristics of the new covenant the LORD will make with his people?
- 5. God continues to be interested in the life and death of birds. Many of Jesus' teachings take the laws of Deuteronomy and expand them. Read and discuss Matthew 10:28-31.
- 6. What do New Testament authors such as Paul teach about the Law of Moses? Read and discuss Galatians 5:13-18.

- 7. How do you love God in the way you relate to creation? Other people? All the details of life?
