Think about and discuss one or two questions from each section.

The text - Luke 24:50-53

1. Read Luke 24:50-53. This is Luke's description of Christ's ascension which occurs 40 days after the day of resurrection about which Luke has written in Luke 24:1-49. Describe what happens. Is there anything that is hard to understand? What questions do you have about the ascension?

The Scriptures – Luke 24:50-53 as a portion of the Scriptures

- 2. Luke describes the ascension again in Acts 1:6-11. What new understanding do we gain from this description?
- 3. In Luke, there are a couple of key moments at which the ascension is anticipated. Read both Luke 9:28-31 and Luke 9:51. What words are used to speak about the ascension on these occasions?
- 4. Read Ephesians 4:7-10 (in which the apostle quotes Psalm 68:18). What is being taught about the consequences of Christ's ascension in this important passage?
- 5. Paul also teaches about the ascension in Romans 8:34. What is the main point he makes in this text?

Our lives – walking the way of Jesus in response to Luke 24:50-53 as a portion of the Scriptures

- 6. We often speak about Christ's death and resurrection. Perhaps we think and talk less about the ascension. Do you think that is the case? If so, why?
- 7. How has this study on Christ's ascension impacted you? What difference has it made to you?
- 8. How can we be praying for you as you continue in your journey as a disciple of Jesus?
