- 1. Read 19:1-9. What role does Moses have in this text? How does God relate to him and to the people of Israel?
- 2. In 19:4-6 the "covenant" that God is establishing with Israel is described. Discuss this covenant. How has it been established? What does God expect of Israel? What are Israel's privileges and responsibilities?

- 3. Because of Jesus, coming to know and love God is now very different than it was when Israel came to meet God at Mount Sinai. Read and discuss the contrasts made in Hebrews 12:18-24.
- 4. Read 1 Peter 2:9-11. How does Peter use the words of Exodus 19 as he writes to God's people in the 1st century?
