- 2. In Proverbs 11:24-26 we have three proverbs about giving and receiving. What are the main points being made in each of these three proverbs?
- 3. What is the warning in Proverbs 11:27?

- 4. There are many portions in the Scriptures about giving and receiving, gaining and losing. Read the words of Jesus in Matthew 16:24-26. What are the main points that Jesus makes here?
- 5. What were core values or characteristics of the early church in Jerusalem? Read and discuss Acts 2:42-47.
- 6. Paul often teaches about giving generously in his letters. Read and discuss 2 Corinthians 9:6-8.
