Strength in Weakness 2 Corinthians 12:1-10



Think about and discuss one or two questions from each section.

The text – 2 Corinthians 12:1-10

- 1. Read 2 Corinthians 12:1-10. Discuss what happened to Paul 14 years ago. What is the third heaven? Paradise? Why does he say "I know a man ..." rather than speak directly about himself?
- 2. 2 Corinthians 12:5 is really important. Paul will only boast about one thing. What is it? Why is this Paul's boast?
- 3. Why does Paul have a "thorn in the flesh"? What is the reason this was given to him?
- 4. How do you reconcile "was given" (presumably by God) with "a messenger of Satan"? How can the thorn in the flesh be both?
- 5. Why did Paul only pray three times? What did he conclude about the thorn in the flesh after these times of prayer?
- 6. What do you understand about the relationship between grace, power and weakness?
- 7. What does Paul mean in 2 Corinthians 12:10 by the phrase "for the sake of Christ"?

The Scriptures – 2 Corinthians 12:1-10 as a portion of the Scriptures

- 8. Also read the words of Paul in 2 Corinthians 4:7-12. These speak to the same themes as 2 Corinthians 12. Compare and contrast these passages.
- 9. How is Paul's experience like that of Jesus? Paul seeks to live in imitation of Jesus. Do you find similarities between what Paul experiences and what Jesus experienced?
