- 2. Discuss Luke 19:10. What does "Son of Man" means as a name for Jesus? How does the Son of Man "seek" and "save" the lost?

- 3. Jesus has already told some three stories about being lost and found in Luke 15:1-32. Read and discuss one of these three stories. What stands out as important about being lost and found?
- 4. In 1 Timothy 1:12-16 Paul writes about he turned to God and was found. What do we learn about God's grace and mercy in that passage?
