Revelation 19:1-10



The text - Revelation 19:1-10

- 1. Read Revelation 19:1-10. What does the word "Hallelujah" mean? Note the four times it is used in Revelation 19:1, 3, 4 and 6. Discuss each of the uses, comparing and contrasting them and gaining as much understanding as you can about this important word.
- 2. Who are the 24 elders and the four living creatures in 19:4?
- 3. The first mention of the "wedding of the Lamb" occurs in 19:7 and then again in 19:9. What do you understand this event to mean?
- 4. What are the righteous deeds of the saints, pictured here as "fine linen"? Think back to the seven messages to the churches in Revelation 2 and 3 as you consider this question.
- 5. What do you learn about the angel who is speaking to John in 19:10?
- 6. Notice the references to God as three-in-one in 19:10. Discuss these references, particularly the role of the Spirit of God.

The Scriptures - Revelation 19:1-10

- 7. There are many uses of "Hallelujah" in the OT Scriptures, particularly in the Psalms, in which the word is sometimes translated "Praise the LORD". Read as one example, Psalm 26, which is a psalm of vindication. Compare this psalm with Revelation 19.
- 8. There are many places throughout Scripture where we learn about feasting and banqueting with God. Read Isaiah 25:6-8, one of the important passages in shaping the book of Revelation. Also read the words of Jesus in Matthew 26:26-29. Discuss the importance of these passages for Revelation 19:6-9.
